

IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS

As a voter within the North County Fire Protection District (“District”) you are asked to vote on a special tax proposed for adoption by resolution of the District’s Board of Directors to be levied annually on each taxable parcel within the jurisdictional boundaries of the District in an amount not to exceed \$60 per parcel per year, commencing with fiscal year 2020-21, for 20 consecutive years.

Use of Special Tax Revenue. The revenue raised will be used only to: 1) finance the cost of construction of certain fire stations; 2) fund a facilities fund for capital improvement and replacement of fire station facilities, and 3) pay for costs associated with the determination of the amount and the levy and collection of the special tax.

Appropriation Limit. The District’s appropriation limit will increase in accordance with the amount of revenue raised by the special tax.

Two-thirds Voter Approval Required. Two-thirds of those voting on this measure must approve the special tax in order for the tax to be adopted.

A “YES” vote is a vote in favor of the special tax.

A “NO” vote is a vote against the special tax.
